

Chad's Survey Success Secrets

First and foremost, I would like to personally commend you on making the wise decision of joining Get Paid Taking Surveys. Before you get started I urge you to read this entire report as it will help familiarize you with the Get Paid Taking Surveys opportunity and get you started off on the right foot towards your online survey taking success.

Before we begin, what are the benefits of doing online surveys?

- Guaranteed payment for your survey taking.
- People can normally make between \$10-\$25 their first day.
- Most market research companies have easy payment methods such as PayPal, cashier's checks, and more.
- You may receive unreleased coupons or products via e-mail for your input. You may also see videos and upcoming shows that have not been released as well.
- Most survey sites also offer sweepstakes offers, so if you take a survey you may be a contestant to win a large pot of money.
- You make your own schedule.

I will give you the link to the market research companies database in a minute. That is where you will find all the links to sign-up with the various market research companies. These companies pay out hundreds of thousands of dollars annually to paid survey takers like you.

Before going over to the market research companies directory and applying for the surveys, we have listed some guidelines, tools, and tricks for your benefit. If you follow the guidelines, use the resources, and apply the tricks below, you will become a professional paid survey taker in no-time.

Step 1: Set-up a separate and **dedicated e-mail account for surveys**

When signing up with market research companies some will allow you to start taking surveys right away, but many will notify you via e-mail when you've been selected to join a particular survey. Once you get your feet wet, you will start

getting A LOT of invitations and you definitely don't want to miss any of these e-mail survey offers. We highly recommend you create a separate e-mail address just for your survey invites. This way, you don't flood your personal e-mail box and you can keep your new survey "business" separate.

By setting up a separate account:

- You will be better organized
- You won't have any mix-ups between your personal and business e-mails
- You won't miss any survey offers
- You will have one stop for all your business needs

We also highly recommend that you organize your survey offers with folders. Create separate "folders" in your e-mail account for each of the survey companies you are registered with. This will enable you to organize and file important information that is e-mailed to you by these companies.

Your Internet Service Provider (AOL, EarthLink, Comcast, etc.) should be able to provide you with an additional e-mail address at no extra charge. Or, you can also set-up a free e-mail address at [Yahoo](#), [Hotmail](#), or [Gmail](#).

It will only take a few minutes to setup, so we advise you to go to one of the following websites and create an e-mail account to use solely for surveys:

Important note: You do NOT need to tell us about new e-mails that you set up, because the e-mail address you used when you signed up with our program has nothing to do with the e-mail address you use when taking surveys. Just use the new address for surveys.

Step 2: Download Survey Software: [RoboForm](#)

The "hardest" part about making money taking surveys, focus groups, etc. is registering with all of the market research companies because there are so many of them! You have to register with each market research company you're interested in to get started. Unfortunately, there is no way to completely automate the registration process, but we have found the next best thing...

[RoboForm](#)—this software program will significantly reduce the time it takes you to fill out forms, register with research companies, and fill out surveys by

automating the process. It will even remember ALL the user names and passwords that you create! Don't worry; there is NO Spyware or Adware on it. I highly recommend using [RoboForm](#) – I use it every day, and if you're serious about making money from surveys then you should be using it too. So please, download it now and spend a few minutes familiarizing yourself with how it works. It will significantly reduce the time you spend getting started, which will help you to make money as quickly as possible.

Step 3: Start registering with market research companies and watch the cash come in!

Now that you're all set-up and ready to go, I just want to share a few more tips and tricks to help you get started. I know you're anxious to get going and you're almost there.

Note: One thing to keep in mind is that when we talk about registering with a company, we're talking about the market research companies that actually conduct surveys and focus groups. They are generally hired by large corporations to do the research on their behalf.

Now, you're not going to "get rich quick" by taking surveys, but once you get going, you CAN easily generate a steadystreamofcash,prizesandfreeproducts. I know lots of people that make anywhere from a few hundred to thousands of dollars per month.

Your success with Get Paid Taking Surveys will primarily depend on:

1. The number of market research companies that you register with

2. Your “profile” which determines the number and type of invitations you get
3. The amount of time you spend participating in surveys, focus groups, etc
4. How lucky you are when it comes to drawings, raffles, and sweepstakes

Let’s briefly go over each of these four items ...

1. The Number of Market Research Companies That You Register With

This is probably the most important factor that will determine your “success” or “failure;” the more companies you register with, the more invitations you’ll receive, the more surveys you can take, and the more money you will make.

The number of companies you register with should reflect your goals and the amount of money you want to make. It really is as simple as that.

If you just want to make a few hundred extra bucks a month to cover a car payment, you definitely don’t need to register with all the companies in our database. Just register with a few at a time when it fits your schedule, and before long you’ll reach your goal.

On the other hand, if your goal is to make thousands of dollars a month, then you need to register with as many companies as you possibly can—the more the better.

Don’t register with 20 companies and expect to make thousands a month—it just won’t happen for you. Please...you need to be realistic.

I’ve personally registered with over 250 companies and I currently receive more invitations than I can handle. So what I do is just “cherry pick” the best ones. Once you get the initial work out of the way, this is a great position to be in!

2. Your “Profile” Which Determines the Number and Type of Opportunities You Get

When you register with a market research company, you’ll be asked various questions which will make up your personal “profile”. Be honest—this is how they match you up with the profiles desired for particular surveys and focus groups.

Some surveys are very general, but others are very specific. For example, a company may want to get the opinions of men between the ages of 25-45 on various types of cologne. If you’re a woman, you won’t be selected to participate in this survey.

Provide as much detailed information as you possibly can, in order to give yourself the best chance of getting selected for as many surveys as possible.

Always provide real information and your honest opinion. If you are dishonest, then your opinion is worthless to these companies because they want to hear what you think to help better their product or company. Don't risk not getting any more surveys or getting stuck at the same dollar amount of surveys. This is one of those times when it really does pay to be honest!

Updating your profile and adding your birthday, personal interests, and simple things like your occupation, will help increase your chances of receiving more surveys tremendously. Once again, it ALL depends on your profile. Your profile determines the frequent flow of surveys that gets sent into your e-mail.

3. The Amount of Time You Spend Participating in Surveys and Focus Groups

Aside from #1, this is the next most important factor that you have FULL control over. And again, the time and effort you put into it has to be in line with your goals.

If you only have 1 hour per week to devote to surveys that's fine—just don't expect to make a full-time income. You'll get out of this what you put into it, as they say.

On the bright side, you only have to register with each company once and then they will usually continue sending you surveys for years! If you don't have a lot of free time every day, be like the turtle—slow and steady wins the race.

4. How Lucky You Are When it Comes to Drawings, Raffles, and Sweepstakes

If you only want to participate in surveys and focus groups that pay cash, that's fine. However, we suggest you consider those that pay in prizes, sweepstakes entries, etc., as well.

If you have the extra time, it's well worth it to take a short 2 minute survey and be entered into a \$10,000 drawing. Wouldn't you agree? Sometimes the odds are pretty good and you can win cash, nice electronic equipment, household items, etc.

Plus, it's important to realize that market research companies change their offerings all the time depending on what kind of research and surveys their clients need.

A company offering prizes this month might offer a \$150 paid survey next month. This is why we highly recommend you register with as many companies as you can regardless of what they are currently offering—you just never know!

There's not a whole lot you can do to influence how lucky you'll be, but just realize that the prizes are often significant and can really make a difference for you.

A Few More Important Reminders Before You Get Started...

1. Some companies will enter you into a contest or sweepstakes when you initially register with them. This is how you build your profile and get started with them. They will often send you “screener” surveys, and then paid surveys will usually follow shortly thereafter.
2. Besuretocheckyoure-mailoften,andactquickly! The companies will often send out more invitations than they need participants, because they know some people won't respond for one reason or another. But once they have enough people, it might be too late for you.
3. Some of the sites and market research companies you'll be introduced to work with various sponsors, promotional companies, etc. And sometimes you'll be invited to purchase products and participate in trial offers as well. You can safely ignore these offers if you're not interested.
4. Most likely there is a minimum payout requirement before you can receive your earnings. For most survey sites, it takes around - weeks for a newly launched survey to finish and confirm your payment when the study has finished. Be patient, your money is on its way!
5. Have some fun! You're providing a very valuable service that will help influence new products, etc. You should be proud of what you're doing and have some fun while making money!

Step 4: Make Sure Your Computer is Running Smoothly

Since you will be making money on using your computer every day, it is highly recommended that your computer is free from spyware and viruses so you can work at optimum levels.
